

Poster presentation guidelines:

Each author will have an **useable area measuring 70 cm wide x 90 cm high**. Poster materials should not extend outside the assigned board.

- Abstract title should be in UPPER CASE
- Prepare a heading at the top of your poster indicating the abstract title, authors, affiliations and presenting author's email.
- Summarize current research in graphic form whenever possible; use charts, tables, graphs, pictures, etc. and minimize the amount of text.
- Details of methodology should be brief.
- The necessary material and other support will be provided at the venue.

Oral presentation Guidelines (Competitive):

- Oral presentations will be scheduled in three different Halls. The final version of the program will be updated one week before the event.
- Oral presenters will be allocated total 10 minutes; 8 minutes for presentation and 2 minutes for questions and answers round.
- The content slides should give an overview of the research with conclusions and future research direction and presenters should ensure that presentation is completed within allocated time.
- All presenters should bring their slides in scanned pen drive to the respective Halls at least 2 hours in advance of their presentation.
